GOLF COURSE RULES DURING COVID-19 CAPTAIN'S COVE MEMBERS & PAYING GUEST OF A MEMBER

- 1. Captain's Cove Member in Good Standing are allowed 1 paying Guest to play with them. Guests must play with the CCGYC Member, and are not allowed to play on their own.
- 2. Hours of operation are 12:00PM 6:00PM Wednesday Sunday
- 3. Captain's Cove golf carts are not available for rent. You are welcome to walk or use your private cart.
- 4. All play must begin on the first hole.
- 5. Play is limited to nine (9) holes.
- 6. Social distancing rules (6' distance between players) must be maintained at all times. Face masks must be worn until the player tees off on #1 and again after putting out on #9. All golfers are required to wear a face mask when within 6' of another person while on the course.
- 7. A maximum of two people will be allowed per tee time. Singles are welcome to obtain a tee time.
- 8. Tee times: Call 757-824-3465 X 118 or email the Pro Shop at proshop@captscove.com from 12 PM to 3 PM to request a tee time. You may request a tee time up to 48 hours in advance. You will receive a confirmation if your time is available. You must provide the names of both people in your group, and we may also ask for your address to verify eligibility to play. Tee times will be provided in 15-minute increments from 12PM to 4PM. You may request no more than two tee times per week.
- 9. The Town Center is closed. There will be no food or beverage sales.
- 10. Alcohol is prohibited from the golf course until the amenity is reopened for regular business.
- 11. There are no trash cans on the course. Do not litter. Take your trash with you.
- 12. Only direct family members may ride together in a privately-owned cart.
- 12.900 unhaisphaeffeach the bunkers/sand traps or pull the ball out. There will not be any rakes on the course.
- 14. No "ball hawking". Time spent looking for lost golf balls is to be kept to a minimum. No retrieving golf balls out of the ponds.
- 15. The restroom facilities are closed at the Town Center. The Ladies room on #7 is closed. All golfers may use the Men's restroom at #7. Do not relieve yourself on the golf course.
- 16. Do not touch the flag stick. The cups have been raised. Once your ball has hit the cup it is considered holed.
- 17. No congregating on the Pro Shop porch before or after the round. Complete play and leave the course
- 18. The Starters and Marshals are volunteers. Do not harass them.
- 19. Please be conscious of pace of play. Please play 'ready golf'; don't be the bottleneck.
- 20. Anyone caught violating these rules will be asked to leave the course. You and your partner's names will be put on a 'not allowed to play' list for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days.

CAPTAIN'S COVE GOLF COMMITTEE RULES DURING COVID-19

During this uncertain time, we want people to be able to have a good time and be able to play golf while adhering to the Governor's Social Distancing rules.

Some people believe rules don't apply to them. There will be Marshals on the course looking for rules infractions. Below are the penalties if a Marshal sees you violating a rule:

- 1. Failure to wear a face mask when necessary or failure to practice Social Distancing: First offense reminder. Second offense: You will be directed to leave the course and will be banned from playing for either 29 days or until the amenities reopen, whichever occurs first.
- 2. Slow play: You will be asked to pick up the pace.
- 3. Failure to start on the 1st hole or "jumping" on the course without a tee time: First offense: You will be directed to leave the course. Second offense: You will be directed to leave the course and will be banned from playing for either 29 days or until the amenities reopen, whichever occurs first.
- 4. "Ball hawking": You will be asked to stop and continue playing.
- 5. Alcohol on the course: You will be directed to leave the course and will be banned from playing for either 29 days or until the amenities reopen, whichever occurs first.
- 6. Urinating on the course: You will be directed to leave the course and will be banned from playing for either 29 days or until the amenities reopen, whichever occurs first.
