



2017 Trail Fee Info and Application for Private Golf Carts

1. On 5 November 2016 the Captain's Cove Board of Directors unanimously approved the Golf Committee recommendation that all CCGYC residents be allowed to use personal golf carts on the course, not just those adjacent to the course. The BOD has instructed the Golf Committee to draft the terms and conditions under which their decision would be implemented.
2. This action expands the previously approved allowance for members living adjacent to the course. To alleviate concerns regarding privately owned golf carts, the following use restrictions are imposed:
 - a) Members must be in good standing to apply for a trail fee and use a privately owned cart.
 - b) All privately owned golf cart owners shall obey all of the CCGYC golf course rules posted at the golf course.
 - c) The driver/operator of the cart must be at least 16 years old and a licensed driver.**
 - d) Neither CCGYC nor BCG is liable for any damages or bodily injury resulting from the use of a privately owned golf cart. Private golf cart owners are personally responsible for any/all damage caused by their cart to the golf course, adjoining properties or any other properties, or to CCGYC roads and common areas regardless of who is driving the cart.
 - e) Privately owned carts may be taken on any road to transit to the golf course, play the round, and transit directly home. The only exception would be stopping at the mail boxes adjacent to the Towne Center Grill. Golf carts must have golf clubs on the cart when in use.
 - f) Privately owned golf carts may not be used on the golf course prior to the opening of the pro shop, as all players must check in prior to playing. All privately owned golf carts must be off the course and roads before sunset. This does not apply during the reduced hours in the winter months when the pro shop is expected to be closed two days a week. During that time privately owned carts may be used on the course but must be aware of frost delays and must be off the course and roads before sunset.
 - g) Privately owned golf carts shall be treated the same as any other conveyance (car or boat) and shall be required to be parked on a driveway (or other hard surface designated for the parking of vehicles) or in a shed/garage when not in use.
 - h) Owners shall be required to purchase (at a minimum) liability insurance on the golf cart and provide proof of same to Mr. Andrew Leach, Golf Course Superintendent.
 - i) Privately held golf carts must pass an inspection performed by Mr. Andrew Leach, Golf Course Superintendent.
 - j) Once inspected and liability insurance has been demonstrated, privately owned golf carts shall be given a CCGYC sticker that is to be placed on the wind screen of the cart for easy identification.
 - k) All maintenance of privately owned golf carts shall be the responsibility of the owner.

- l) Privately owned golf cart users are required to check in at the Pro Shop prior to commencing play. All play is to commence on the first tee unless the pro shop deems otherwise.
- m) Privately owned golf cart owners shall be required to pay a \$300 annual trail fee to CCGYC. The trail fee for a household of two golfers shall be \$450 per year. This is an annual plan that runs from April 1, 2017 to March 31, 2018. Additional trail fees for members residing in the same household shall be \$100 per year per person. The reduced fee (relative to the cart plan) is due to the individual owner's expense for the purchase, maintenance, insurance and full upkeep of the cart.
- n) If an owner of a private cart who has paid the trail fee wants to use a CCGYC cart (their cart down for maintenance, etc.) they shall pay the standard cart rental fee.
- o) Trail fees will not be prorated.
- p) By signing below I acknowledge the rules and regulations associated with private golf cart ownership.

3. Any violations of the above rules will result in the following punishments as determined by the BOD and implemented under the authority of the BOD by the BCG Golf Pro and/or Assistant Golf Pro:

- a) First Offense: Warning.
- b) Second Offense: Loss of the use of the privately owned cart for seven (7) days.
- c) Third and any subsequent offense/s: Loss of the use of the privately owned cart for thirty (30) days.
