



Safety Policies and Guidelines

We will follow and practice current CDC and Government Guidelines and phases. As restrictions or guidelines change, we will inform and adjust as needed.

Mitigation Practices

- Social Distancing – remain at least 6 feet apart from other people
- Face masks are not required for children
- Temperature will be taken daily and recorded for campers and instructors on arrival
- Staff to wear gloves while serving food
- Wash your hands for at least 20 seconds with soap and water
- No more than 10 people can gather in the same area/space
- No sharing of clubs, golf balls, drink bottles, or food

Safety

- We have a safety zone – an area set up to send campers if ill, troublesome.
- We have set up all stations with proper 6-foot spacing with cones, markers, tape, chalk, string, in advance – mats on range, spacing for putting, chipping, bunkers, all at least six feet apart
- Safety procedures will be covered with campers at each station
- Limit the number of campers to max. 8 per group, and keep in the same social group
- Break areas set up for drinking sitting down and resting.

Management must provide

- Instructors and counselors with face masks
- Instructors and counselors with gloves
- Sanitizer stations

All Instructors and Camp Counselors

- Must wear a face mask
- Must wear gloves while serving food
- Wash/sanitize hands between stations
- Avoid all contact with campers
- Wash hands before and after camps
- If not feeling well, staff are not come work. Do not take the risk.
- Each Counselor/Instructor must have sanitizer wipes on hand

Teaching/Practice/On course stations

- No carts – walking only
- Stations are set up to keep campers at least 6ft” apart
- Mats/range stations – 10ft spacing
- Groups of 8 or less students to one coach
- Students will stay in same social group for all 5 days.

On Course

- Check with GM for course availability for each week or day the week prior
- Walking Only – when or until restrictions change
- Must be able to carry or pull their own golf clubs

Golf Clubs

- Recommended that each camper has their own golf clubs and only uses their own.
- For those without clubs we will assign a set to the camper for the week (Wood, 7 iron, wedge, putter) no other camper touches that set for the week
- We will provide campers specific colored golf balls for all activities on and around putting green. They are to only touch own assigned color golf balls.

Weather

- Cancellation/refund policies for missed days because of weather.
- Notifications (24 hours) (2 hours prior to camp start)

Camper registration

- Check in table
- Hand sanitizer on table
- Temperature to be taken and recorded upon arrival
- Name label everything with Sharpie
- Put in a space with plenty of room so there is no congestion
- Preassigned groups – send camper to their assigned station/instructor
- No pre-camp large group announcements session will be held
